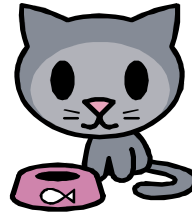

I love dogs and cats and thought it was a great idea to help our local animal shelter.

Our local animal shelter has been concerned with animal welfare for over 125 years. It has been providing shelter, health care, and adoption services for unwanted animals since 1874. It is committed to finding homes for adoptable cats and dogs, providing affordable veterinary and spay/neuter services, and educating the public on responsible pet ownership.

Suggested Items [Suggest cost limited to \$10]:

FOR DOGS:

- **Puppy Food**
- **Dog Treats** to fill their volunteer and staff treats bags(no rawhides please)
- **Velvet Bimples, marrow bones, nyla bones or other edible bones/chewtoys**
- Used or new Bath sized towels for dogs(no sheets/blankets)
- Lamb and Rice Dry Dog Food
- Wet Dog Food
- Dog toys, especially Large [Kongs](#), but also toys for fetch.
- Clean Nylon or Leather Leashes (new or used)
- Plastic Poop Bags
- Dry Dog Food Storage Containers

FOR CATS:

- **Dry Cat and/or Kitten food** (prefer Premium Edge or Professional Brand)
- **Wet Kitten food** (not shredded or chunky)
- **Cat toys** - no feathers or small parts (hard plastic toys that can be easily disinfected are great)
- Cat toy wands / interactive
- Cat Brushes
- Lint Rollers
- Carpet Samples
- Dry Cat Food Storage Containers

Bolded items are needed the most. My Goal is to donate a least 100 items to the shelter
